

WEEKLY SUMMARY OF NON-ROUTINE ACTIVITY CITY OF COLLEGE PARK CONTRACT POLICE SERVICE

July 22-July 28, 2016

- 7/23** Contract officer responded to a call for service for the activation of a burglary alarm at 9200 block Saint Andrews Place. Contract officer was the first unit to arrive on the scene and determined the alarm was accidentally activated by the homeowner.
- 7/23** Contract officer responded to a call for service for a report of a child drowning in a pool at 7300 block Milestone Way. EMS transported the child in stable condition.
- 7/23** Contract officer observed a student with a historical sign in the 4700 block of Norwich Road. As the officer approached the student fled into a house in 4700 block but the officer was unable to locate the suspect. Report was submitted
- 7/25** Contract officer responded to a call for service for a report of a theft from auto at 4800 block Lackawanna Road. The suspect's description was broadcasted and the contract officer stopped the suspect. The suspect was placed under arrest and was turned over to the beat officer for processing. Note: officers were familiar with the suspect as he had priors for burglaries and thefts.
- 7/25** Contract officer responded to a head on collision involving 3 vehicles at Rhode Island Ave and Hollywood Road. 3 victims were transported to the hospital in stable condition.
- 7/26** Contract officer stopped and spoke to the gentleman that was sleeping in his vehicle at 5700 block Vassar Drive. Warrant check was negative
- 7/26** Contract officer conducted a traffic assignment (Stop Sign Enforcement) at Calvert Road and Princeton Ave. 5 warning citations were issued.
- 7/26** Contract officer stopped a panhandler at Baltimore Ave and Edgewood Road. The officer issued a citation for panhandling.
- 7/27** Contract officer and Beat officer responded to a call for service for a report of a Breaking and Entering at 4200 block Knox Road. Suspect entered through a window, removed property and fled the scene. Investigation is ongoing
- 7/28** Contract officer conducted a traffic stop at Baltimore Ave and Campus Drive (Paint Branch Parkway). The officer discovered the driver was wanted on 2 outstanding warrants and was placed under arrest without incident.
