

EMERGENCY ABSENTEE BALLOT REQUEST

From October 28, 2015 – November 3, 2015, a voter who is eligible to vote by absentee ballot may apply for an emergency ballot in person at City Hall (4500 Knox Road) from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

To be eligible to vote by absentee ballot, a registered voter must meet one of the following qualifications:

- May be absent on election day from the City;
- Because of accident, illness or physical disability, will be unable to go to the polling place on election day;
- Because of confinement in or restriction to an institution, will be prevented from going to a polling place on election day;

- Because of a death or serious illness in the voter's immediate family, will be unable to go to the polling place on election day; or
- Is a full-time student at an institution of higher education located outside the City, and academic requirements prevent the voter from going to the polling place on Election Day.

Absentee ballots are counted on Wednesday, November 4, 2015.

Attick Towers will open its wait list from November 2, 2015 to November 20, 2015. Attick Towers is an independent living high-rise apartment building located at 9014 Rhode Island Avenue in College Park, Maryland.

All applicants must be 62 years of age or older or be a disabled or handicapped adult. Applicants do not have to reside in College Park to apply; however, people who live or work in the City of College Park will have preference. No children can be accepted. Applicants are subject to a credit and criminal background check.

Applicants should be prepared to move within 30 days once a unit is available. Rent is based on 30 percent of one's income. Attick Towers has efficiency apartments for one person occupancy and one bedroom apartments for two person occupancy. All applicants are required to pay a security deposit equal to one month's rent or \$300, whichever is less.

THE CITY WILL BE CLOSED FOR THE THANKSGIVING HOLIDAY, THURSDAY AND FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 26 & 27, 2015

City departments are closed to observe the Thanksgiving holiday. Refuse and recycling will be collected on your regular collection day, but there will be NO special collections for brush, electronics, or bulky trash during the week of Thanksgiving.

CURBSIDE LEAF COLLECTION BEGINS NOVEMBER 2, 2015

Starting Monday, November 2, the Public Works Department will begin curbside vacuum collection of leaves. Look for signs posted in your neighborhood for collection dates or visit www.collegetparkmd.gov and click on Curbside Leaf Collection on the left side under Latest News for the collection schedule.

Until curbside leaf vacuum collection begins, residents should continue to set out yard waste on regularly scheduled collection days (same day as refuse and recycling collection), using only paper yard waste bags or properly labeled reusable containers (reusable containers must display a yard waste sticker, available to City residents at City buildings). Weekly yard waste collection will end on October 30th. Brush, branches, sticks, and shrubs are collected Thursdays and Fridays by appointment only; call 240-487-3590 or email publicworks@collegetparkmd.gov before setting your brush out at the curb. Brush collections will continue throughout the duration of curbside leaf collection.

Look for the posted signs in your neighborhood to know when curbside leaf collection will occur. Collection schedules are tentative; please refer to the city website or contact Public Works for the most updated information.

NOTE: To stay on schedule, leaf trucks will not be able to return to collect your leaves once they have already been through your street. Each area of the City is scheduled to be serviced at least 4 times during this period, so you will have several opportunities to have your leaves collected. Additionally, our vacuum hoses are not able to reach around cars or other obstructions, so it is imperative that your leaves are not blocked.

UMD GAME-DAY TEXT ALERTS

If you would like to receive game day information text alerts regarding incidents, traffic problems, notifications about the start and end of incoming and outgoing traffic pertaining to sporting events, send a text message from your mobile device to 888777 with keyword: TerpsGameDay.

LEAF COLLECTION PROCEDURES

DO:

- Rake leaves, grass, flowers, and light clippings to the curb (but not in the street) - you do not need to bag these items
- Pile leaves away from cars and storm drains – piles blocked by obstacles will not be collected
- Watch for the posted signs in your neighborhood to know when to rake your leaves to the curb. Visit the website for updates to the collection schedule.

DO NOT:

- Include brush, branches, sticks, bamboo, vines, rocks, or debris (trash) in your leaf piles. These items may damage the leaf vacuums and delay collection.
- Use plastic bags for leaves and clippings. You also do not need to use paper bags or reusable containers during curbside leaf vacuum collection.
- Block storm drains or fire hydrants, as this can lead to storm water and emergency access problems.
- Pile leaves in the street. Leaves in the street can create a slipping hazard, parking problems, and clog storm drains.

SMARTLEAF® COMPOST

SMARTLEAF® compost is available for sale at the Department of Public Works and is \$25.00 per cubic yard (includes tax). Wood mulch remains unavailable. Material may be picked up at Public Works Monday through Friday 8:00 – 11:30 a.m. and 1:00 – 3:30 p.m. Deliveries have been suspended for the season. If you would like to be notified when deliveries resume and/or when wood mulch is available, please sign up with College Park Connected, which can be accessed from the City website homepage at <http://www.collegetparkmd.gov>. Click on the green “College Park Connected! Sign Up Now” button. After entering your information, choose “SMARTLEAF compost and wood mulch” right above the Sign Up button.
