Special Session of the College Park City Council
Tuesday, March 21, 2006

During the regularly scheduled Worksession of the College Park City Council on March 21, 2006, a motion was made by Councilmember Fellows and seconded by Councilmember Peña-Melnyk to enter Special Session. The motion passed 8-0-0.

Action Items:

06-G-48 To provide direction to Staff regarding Curley's Grill: To request a continuance of the 3/28/06 hearing before the Board of License Commissioners; if the continuance is not granted, to authorize staff to represent no objection to the Liquor License application before the BOLC contingent upon successfully negotiating a Property Use Agreement with Alan Wanuck/Curley's Grill, that is consistent with other agreements.

The aforementioned Motion was made by Councilmember Peña-Melnyk and seconded by Councilmember Fellows.

There was no comment from the audience on this agenda item, and no further Council comment.

The motion passed 7-0-1; Councilmember Olson abstained.

The Special Session was recessed at 10:45 p.m. by a vote of 8-0-0.

At 1:36 a.m. (March 22), a motion was made by Councilmember Fellows and seconded by Councilmember Peña-Melnyk to reconvene the Special Session. The motion carried 8-0-0.

06-G-49 To Approve a Letter Of Support For HB 509 – Character Education Fund

A motion was made by Councilmember Krouse and seconded by Councilmember Hampton to send a letter of support for HB 509, and to authorize the City's Education Advisory Committee to advocate for the bill.
