

**MINUTES**  
**Special Session of the College Park City Council**  
**Tuesday, October 16, 2007**  
**9:48 P.M.**

**PRESENT:** Mayor Brayman; Councilmembers Milligan, Krouse, Catlin, Perry, Fellows, Stullich, Hampton and Cook; Student Liaison Danielle Kogut.

During the October 16 Worksession of the College Park City Council, a motion to enter a Special Session was made by Councilmember Stullich and seconded by Councilmember Fellows. The purpose of the Special Session was to vote on a letter that needs to be sent tomorrow to the Planning Board. The motion carried 8-0-0.

**Action Item:**

**07-G-112 Approval of a Letter to the Prince George's County Planning Board stating the City's Budget Priorities for the FY '09 M-NCPPC Budget**

Prior to the motion, there was discussion about the projects proposed in the staff memo dated October 11, 2007. Mayor Brayman raised a new item: to oppose funding for the Nevada Street path to Lake Artemesia unless an acceptable new alignment for the path is developed that does not infringe on rear yards of houses on Sweetbriar Drive.

A motion was made by Councilmember Stullich and seconded by Councilmember Catlin to send a letter to the Prince George's County Planning Board stating the City's budget priorities in the FY '09 M-NCPPC budget.

**Comments from the audience:**

**Larry Bleau, 4901 Niagara Road:** Had questions about the entrance to the Greenbelt Metro Station from Lackawanna Street.

Councilmember Fellows clarified the motion.

Councilmember Krouse recommended some changes to the letter.

Councilmember Perry asked about the Skate Spot and was told that project was in last year's letter and is not included in this year's request. He suggested new language for the letter in regard to the Hollywood Neighborhood Pavilion.

A motion to amend the letter was made by Councilmember Krouse and seconded by Councilmember Fellows: to delete the 2<sup>nd</sup> sentence in the "Comprehensive Stormwater Management Plan for Hollywood Neighborhood Park Picnic Pavilion" item. There were no comments from the audience on this amendment. The motion carried 8-0-0.

A second motion to amend the letter was made by Councilmember Perry. This motion failed for lack of a second.

The main motion as amended carried by a vote of 8-0-0.

**Adjournment:**

A motion to adjourn from Special Session was made by Councilmember Fellows and seconded by Councilmember Stullich. The Special Session was adjourned at 10:00 p.m. by a vote of 8-0-0.
