**A Charter Amendment Resolution Amending §C3-4 Of The City Charter To Increase The Mayor's Annual Salary To \$7,500 And Each Council Members' Annual Salary To \$5,000 Effective January 1, 2008**

Mayor Brayman opened the Public Hearing at 7:18 p.m. He explained that this proposed Charter Amendment would increase Mayor and Council salaries effective January 1, 2008, and that it would be the next Council that would receive the increase because it will become effective after the election.

Mayor Brayman invited public comment.

**Morgan Gale, 7010 Wake Forest Drive:** Mr. Gale spoke in support of this resolution, stating that the Mayor and Council deserves this amount of pay, if not more.

**Mayor Dervey Lomax, 5013 Navahoe Street:** Mayor Lomax spoke in support of this resolution, stating that the Mayor and Council put in a lot of time for this job and should be paid for it.
