A motion was made by Councilmember Catlin and seconded by Councilmember Mark Cook to request funding from the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission FY 2010 budget for the Construction of a Tot Lot at Lake Artemesia, a new Entrance Gateway to the Hollywood Community Park, Small Area Planning Study and support for the College Park Dog Park.

Councilmember Catlin requested that each item be listed in detail in the letter.

Councilmember Perry stated that the Small Area Planning Study is not in the City and should not be included in this letter.

There were no comments for the audience on this item.

The motion carried 6-1-0. Councilmember Perry opposed.
