

MINUTES
Special Session of the College Park City Council
Tuesday, September 2, 2008
10:15 p.m.

PRESENT: Mayor Brayman; Councilmembers Molinatto, Wojahn, Catlin, Perry, Stullich, Hampton and Mary Cook.

ABSENT: Councilmember Mark Cook.

At 10:15 p.m., during the regularly scheduled Worksession of the College Park City Council, a motion to enter into Special Session was made by Councilmember Stullich and seconded by Councilmember Wojahn. The motion carried 7-0-0. Mayor Brayman noted the Special Session had been advertised on the agenda.

Action Items:

08-G-87 Approval of Program Year 35 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Application

A motion was made by Councilmember Stullich and seconded by Councilmember Catlin to approve project numbers 3, 4 and 5 from the staff memo for the Program Year 35 Community Development Block Grant application. The projects are:

- #3: Widen the sidewalk on the north side of Calvert Road, between Rhode Island Avenue and Hopkins Avenue (estimated cost \$28,000)
- #4: Reconstruct Pontiac Place at Berwyn Neighborhood Playground between Rhode Island Avenue and 49th Avenue (estimated cost \$40,875)
- #5: Pave the alley, in part, between Greenbelt Road and Tecumseh Street, from 48th Avenue to 49th Avenue (estimated cost \$28,265) .

There were no comments from the audience on this item. There were no comments from Council.

The motion carried 7-0-0.

Adjournment: A motion to adjourn the Special Session was made by Councilmember Perry and seconded by Councilmember Catlin. The Special Session was adjourned at 10:20 p.m. by a vote of 7-0-0.
