

WEEKLY SUMMARY OF NON-ROUTINE ACTIVITY CITY OF COLLEGE PARK CONTRACT POLICE SERVICE

- 4/8** Contract officers responded to a call for service for a T/A Robbery at the Starbucks located at 4750 Cherry Hill Road. Officers arrived at the scene and determined the call for service was at 7378 Baltimore Ave. Officers responded to this location after a look out was broadcast to the surrounding talk-groups and jurisdictions. UMPD stopped the suspects at the College Park Metro. Incident was not a robbery but was classified as suspicious persons inside the T/A. Field Observations Report submitted.
- 4/9** Contract officers responded to a call for service for a suspicious person at 4300 block Hartwick Road. The suspect was located and investigation revealed he stole a package. He was cited on a criminal citation. Officers discovered other items (Xbox gaming system) and noted it in their report and forwarded it to the Investigations Section.
Update: A few days later it was determined that the suspect possessions (Xbox) were items taken from a burglary on Knox Road. He will be charged with that breaking and entering.
